Riverton Farmers Market will take place every Wednesday, May 18th-Sept. 28th, between 5 pm and 7 pm at 606 N. 8th West. Customers can expect a variety of milk products. Fresh and aged cheeses, ice cream, butter, cream, sherbet, and ricotta or cottage cheese are often available. There will be grass fed beef (ground, steaks, and roasts) as well as free-range chickens from 3 to 6 lbs. and farm fresh eggs, both chicken and duck. Also a number of talented local bakers will provide a wide and varying range of made-from-scratch goods, while the gardeners and truck farmers will provide a wide range of fresh, flavor packed produce.
